English for IELTS preparation

Intermediate+ (IELTS 5.0+)

For Australian and international students wishing to maximize their performance in the IELTS exam. This course will operate two evenings per week (Tuesday and Thursday) from 6pm to 8pm. In addition to four (4) hours of class time there will be up to an additional twelve (12) hours per week of written homework and class preparation. Note that this course will not be eligible for student visas and will demand a high level of commitment from class participants.
